County Attorney Andrew Thomas announced today that Tammi Peters Smith (DOB 3/12/72) has been indicted on two charges, Conspiracy to Commit Custodial Interference, a class 4 felony; and Forgery, a class 4 felony

These charges relate to the disappearance of Gabriel Johnson. According to the probable cause statement filed by Tempe Police, Smith is accused of withholding information as police investigated the disappearance of Gabriel. The Forgery charge alleges Smith provided false information on paternity documents that inaccurately listed Smith's cousin as the father of Gabriel.

On February 10, 2010 a grand jury handed up the indictment. Deputy County Attorneys Angela Andrews and Belle Whitney are prosecuting the case.

Gabriel's mother, Elizabeth Johnson has already been indicted on kidnapping, child abuse, custodial interference, and conspiracy to commit custodial interference charges.

Thomas stated, "We stand ready to assist investigators and join them in hoping for the safe return of Gabriel."
